

Our (Starbucks) Starbooks Coffee Corner 😂




- 1. Choose a book that "looks" at you.

 happened before the
 line? What happened

after?"

- *Use your vocabulary notebooks to "collect" new words.
- *Teacher-reading time to the class (put your heads on the table).




Activities that took place in every parallel

Each child prepared a set of "emoji": happy, sad, excited, hungry...By the end of the free reading time, the teacher asks: How do you feel? The pupils show the suitable emoji.


Choose (elect) your book...
